CURRICULUM – NCEA PATHWAY

Junior – Year 9 & 10

You will be offered a wide range of subjects to choose from. You will study english, science, mathematics, social studies and at least one language, as well as having lessons in the arts, technology and physical education.

We provide extension pathways in all areas of the junior curriculum and set high expectations for all students.

Senior – Year 11 -13

We will guide you to select subjects that are suited to your interests and strengths and which help you on a path towards future study and careers options.

Extension Pathways will be available in all areas of the curriculum. These are designed to prepare students to sit Scholarship exams in Year 13.
